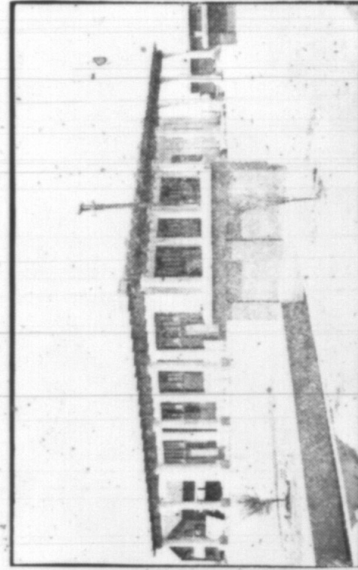


WHERE THE BANK WAS FIRST HOUSED

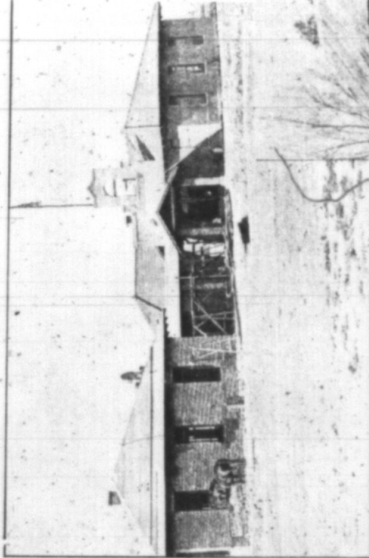
The Bank of Chandler opened for business February 3, 1913, with deposits of about \$5,000. Three months later the rapid development of the territory made more room and better accommodations necessary, and the bank is now housed in a handsome concrete building of its own, costing \$10,000. The bank's business is rapidly growing.



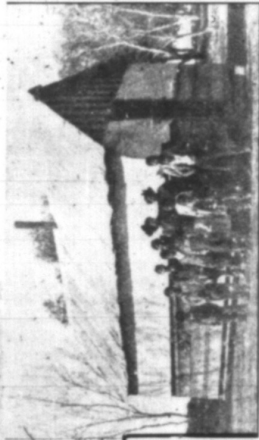
PRESENT QUARTERS OF THE BANK OF CHANDLER

### Chandler School

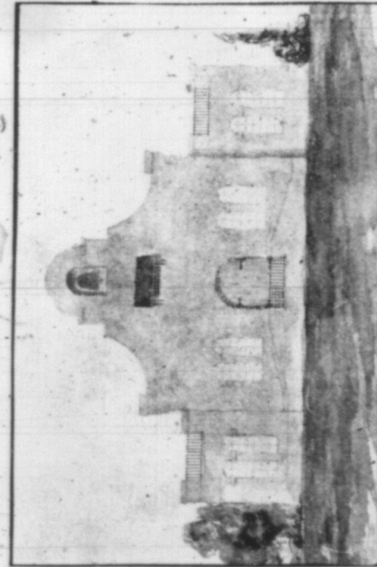
SHOWING THE TWO UNITS AT TIME OF COMPLETION



Chandler schools have grown in eighteen months from a daily attendance of five, a 1912 term, to a daily attendance of five hundred students, housed in two modern buildings costing \$18,000 and boasting a staff of seven teachers. It will be necessary to add the third unit, costing \$5,000, as the capacity of the buildings are already overtaxed.
