My dear Mr. Baird:

Talked with Mr. Loftus this morning. He told me that he had yesterday sent a release of the oil lease on your lands to Yuma for recordation and same would be sent on to you. This being the case you should get it within the next week or ten days. He had taken no action toward a sale of the well equipment so am asking a dealer here in the City to examine it and make an offer. I am going to Phoenix early next week, probably drive, and will stop at the well and see that everything is being taken care of properly. The driller called on me yesterday and told me that according to orders he had reeled the line in oil and covered, also covered the bolt to protect it from the sun, removed the hand plates from the boiler and emptied of water, placed all the small tools in the house and put in charge of the watchman before he left.

Will inform you of any development.
